Section 5. The Respite Program Act is amended by changing
Section 5 as follows:

7 Sec. 5. Eligibility. The The Department may establish eligibility standards for respite services taking into 8 9 consideration the unique economic and social needs of the population for whom they are to be provided. The population 10 11 identified for the purposes of this Act includes persons suffering from Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder and 12 persons who are 60 years of age or older with an identified 13 14 service need. Priority shall be given in all cases to frail or 15 disabled adults.
