1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1292

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1292, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, by replacing line 21 on page 4 through line 4 on page 5 with
5 the following:

6 "(b) A member may establish creditable service, without
7 making contributions, for periods of military service, as
8 defined in Section 2-109, provided that the person received a
9 discharge other than dishonorable, was a member within 6 months
10 prior to military service, and returned to service as a member
11 under this System within one year after discharge.

12 A member may purchase up to 2 years of military service not
13 immediately following service as a member under this System, by
14 paying to the System (1) employee contributions based on the
15 member's salary upon the first date as a member after the
16 military service, plus (2) an amount determined by the board to
17 be equal to the employer's normal cost of the benefit, plus (3)
18 interest on items (1) and (2) at the actuarially assumed rate

1 from the first date as a member after such military service to
2 the date of payment.

3 The total amount of creditable military service for any
4 member during his or her entire term of service shall not
5 exceed 5 years."; and

6 on page 14, by replacing lines 2 through 10 with the following:

7 "(b) A member may establish creditable service, without
8 making contributions, for periods of military service, as
9 defined in Section 14-103.16, provided that the person received
10 a discharge other than dishonorable, was a member within 6
11 months prior to military service, and returned to service as a
12 member under this System within one year after discharge.

13 A member may purchase up to 2 years of military service not
14 immediately following service as a member under this System, by
15 paying to the System (1) employee contributions based on the
16 member's salary upon the first date as a member after the
17 military service, plus (2) an amount determined by the board to
18 be equal to the employer's normal cost of the benefit, plus (3)
19 interest on items (1) and (2) at the actuarially assumed rate
20 from the first date as a member after such military service to
21 the date of payment.

22 The total amount of creditable military service for any
23 member during his or her entire term of service shall not
24 exceed 5 years."; and

1 on page 22, by replacing lines 11 through 19 with the
2 following:

3 "(b) A participant may establish creditable service,
4 without making contributions, for periods of military service,
5 provided that the person received a discharge other than
6 dishonorable, was a participant within 6 months prior to
7 military service, and returned to service as a participant
8 under this System within one year after discharge.

9 A participant may purchase up to 2 years of military
10 service not immediately following service as a participant
11 under this System, by paying to the System (1) employee
12 contributions based on the participant's salary upon the first
13 date as a participant after the military service, plus (2) an
14 amount determined by the board to be equal to the employer's
15 normal cost of the benefit, plus (3) interest on items (1) and
16 (2) at the actuarially assumed rate from the first date as a
17 participant after such military service to the date of payment.

18 The total amount of creditable military service for any
19 participant during his or her entire term of service shall not
20 exceed 5 years."; and

21 on page 31, by replacing lines 6 through 13 with the following:

22 "(b) A member may establish creditable service, without
23 making contributions, for periods of military service,
24 provided that the person received a discharge other than
25 dishonorable, was a member within 6 months prior to military

1 service, and returned to service as a member under this System
2 within one year after discharge.

3 A member may purchase up to 2 years of military service not
4 immediately following service as a member under this System, by
5 paying to the System (1) employee contributions based on the
6 member's salary upon the first date as a member after the
7 military service, plus (2) an amount determined by the board to
8 be equal to the employer's normal cost of the benefit, plus (3)
9 interest on items (1) and (2) at the actuarially assumed rate
10 from the first date as a member after such military service to
11 the date of payment.

12 The total amount of creditable military service for any
13 member during his or her entire term of service shall not
14 exceed 5 years."; and

15 on page 35, line 15, by replacing "8%" with "7%"; and

16 on page 39, by replacing lines 12 through 20 with the
17 following:

18 "(b) A participant may establish creditable service,
19 without making contributions, for periods of military service,
20 provided that the person received a discharge other than
21 dishonorable, was a participant within 6 months prior to
22 military service, and returned to service as a participant
23 under this System within one year after discharge.

24 A participant may purchase up to 2 years of military

1 service not immediately following service as a participant
2 under this System, by paying to the System (1) employee
3 contributions based on the participant's salary upon the first
4 date as a participant after the military service, plus (2) an
5 amount determined by the board to be equal to the employer's
6 normal cost of the benefit, plus (3) interest on items (1) and
7 (2) at the actuarially assumed rate from the first date as a
8 participant after such military service to the date of payment.

9 The total amount of creditable military service for any
10 participant during his or her entire term of service shall not
11 exceed 5 years."
