SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 106/65 new 215 ILCS 170/52.5 new 305 ILCS 5/5-5.06 new

Amends the Children's Health Insurance Program Act, the Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act, and the Illinois Public Aid Code to provide that beginning on July 1, 2009, reimbursement for dental services provided in accordance with the respective Acts may not be lower than 64% of the reimbursement level that the State of Illinois reimburses dentists for dental services provided to State employees under the State Employees Group Insurance Act.

- Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is
 amended by adding Section 65 as follows:

7 Sec. 65. Fee schedule. Beginning on July 1, 2009, 8 reimbursement for any dental service provided to children 9 covered under this Act may not be lower than 64% of the 10 reimbursement level that the State of Illinois reimburses 11 dentists for dental services provided to State employees under 12 the State Employees Group Insurance Act.

Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is amended by adding Section 52.5 as follows:

Sec. 52.5. Fee schedule. Beginning on July 1, 2009, the dentist fee schedule for the Program for any dental service may not be lower than 64% of the reimbursement level that the State of Illinois reimburses dentists for dental services provided to State employees under the State Employees Group Insurance Act.
