## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Energy Assistance Act is amended by changing Section 11 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 20/11) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 1411)
- 7 Sec. 11. Payments to Energy Providers.
- 8 <u>(a)</u> When an energy provider supplies winter energy to a
  9 participant and customer, the provider shall be compensated by
  10 the State of Illinois pursuant to rules promulgated by the
- 11 Department.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, if a
- participant in the energy assistance program under this Act
- 14 <u>resides in housing subsidized or developed with funds provided</u>
- 15 <u>under the Rental Housing Support Program Act or under a similar</u>
- 16 <u>locally funded rent subsidy program, the compensation paid</u>
- 17 <u>under this Act to the energy provider who supplied winter</u>
- 18 <u>energy to the participant shall be paid on behalf of the</u>
- 19 participant or, if the owner is responsible for providing
- 20 <u>winter energy</u>, on behalf of the owner of the housing unit
- 21 providing winter energy to the participant under the rent
- 22 subsidy program.
