6 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding 7 Section 8.33 as follows:

(30 ILCS 805/8.33 new) 9 Sec. 8.33. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8 10 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the 11 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of 12 the 96th General Assembly.

13 Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by text 14 15 that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that text does 16 17 not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any other 18 Public Act.". 19
