SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

515 ILCS 5/10-110

from Ch. 56, par. 10-110

Amends the Fish and Aquatic Life Code. Authorizes persons to take shad and drum by means of a pitchfork, underwater spear gun, bow and arrow device, spear, or gig. Effective immediately.

- 1 AN ACT concerning fish.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The Fish and Aquatic Life Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 10-110 as follows:
- 6 (515 ILCS 5/10-110) (from Ch. 56, par. 10-110)
- 7 Sec. 10-110. Taking carp, buffalo, suckers, gar, and
- 8 bowfin, shad, and drum. Carp, buffalo, suckers, gar, and
- 9 bowfin, shad, and drum may be taken by means of a pitchfork,
- 10 underwater spear gun, bow and arrow or bow and arrow device,
- 11 spear, or gig. Each person taking fish by these means shall
- 12 possess a valid sport fishing license. Fish taken by these
- means shall not be sold or bartered. No other fish may be taken
- in this State by these means.
