Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
General Revenue Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy
Commission for the purposes hereinafter named:
For Personal Services
For State Contributions to the State
Employees' Retirement System838,600
For State Contributions to
Social Security563,500
For Contractual Services354,200
For Travel175,000
For Commodities11,700
For Printing
For Equipment
For Electronic Data Processing45,500
For Telecommunications Services277,600
For Operation of Auto Equipment

- Section 10. The sum of \$187,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Guardianship and Advocacy Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for services pursuant to Section 5 of the Guardianship and Advocacy Act.
