4 Section 20. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Senior Health 6 Insurance Program Fund to the Department of Insurance for the 7 administration of the Senior Health Insurance Program.

The sum of \$485,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 10 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of 11 Insurance for costs associated with the administration and 12 operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois 13 Workers' Compensation Commission's anti-fraud program.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2009.
