4 Section 25. In addition to any other funds appropriated 5 for that purpose, the sum of \$259,500 is appropriated from 6 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Labor for all 7 costs associated with promoting and enforcing the Equal Pay 8 Act and the Victims Economic Security and Safety Act.

9 Section 30. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of 10 Labor Federal Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for all 11 promoting and the 12 costs associated with enforcing occupational safety and health administration state program 13 14 for public sector worksites.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,16 2009.
