Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 10. The sum of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof as
5	is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated
6	to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law
7	Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.
8	Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof
9	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
10	Asbestos Abatement Fund to the Attorney General to meet the
11	ordinary and contingent expenses of the Environmental
12	Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division:

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Section 20. The amount of \$7,750,000, or so much thereof 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney 2 Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment General 3 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use, 5 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the 6 duties of the Attorney General, including State 7 law

enforcement and public education.

- 9 Section 25. The amount of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois 11 Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to 12 enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act 13 and to gather and disseminate information about charitable 14 trustees and organizations to the public.
- Section 30. The amount of \$9,700,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for ordinary and contingent expenses, including State law enforcement purposes.
- Section 35. The amount of \$900,000, or so much thereof 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital

- 1 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial
- 2 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.
- Section 40. The amount of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the 4 5 Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and 6 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in 7 the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris, 8 9 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for 10 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act, and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation. 11
- Section 45. The amount of \$4,350,000, or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney 13 14 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund 15 Attorney General for payment of interagency 16 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties, and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any 17 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the 18 19 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public 20 education.
- 21 Section 50. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's

- 2 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
- 3 which those funds were received.
- 4 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
- 6 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the
- 7 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses
- 8 of the Attorney General:

- 23 Section 60. The amount of \$320,000, or so much thereof

- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support 1
- Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for 2
- 3 child support enforcement purposes.
- Section 65. The amount of \$2,750,000, or so much thereof 4
- 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
- General Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney 6
- General for funding for federal grants. 7
- 8 Section 70. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
- 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender
- Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board 10
- for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management 11
- Board Act including, but not limited to, sex offender 12
- evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants. 13
- 14 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in
- 15 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the
- 16 funding.
- Section 75. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as 17
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide Grand
- Jury Prosecution Fund to the Office of the Attorney General 19
- for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under 20
- 21 the Statewide Grand Jury Act.

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Section 80. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation in accordance with the terms of Section 25 of the Illinois Equal Justice Act.

Section 85. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from the Married Families Domestic Violence Fund pursuant to Public Act 95-711 for grants to public or private nonprofit agencies for the purposes of facilitating or providing free domestic violence legal advocacy, assistance, or services to married or formerly married victims of domestic violence related to order of protection proceedings, or other proceedings for civil remedies for domestic violence.
