AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

Section 17. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Comprehensive 5 Regional Planning Fund to the Department of Transportation 6 for comprehensive regional planning purposes. 7 Each year's follows: 70% to distribution will be 8 as the Chicago 9 Metropolitan Agency on Planning; 25% to the State's other Metropolitan Planning Organizations (exclusive of CMAP) with 10 each MPO receiving a percentage equal to its area population 11 as it relates to the total population of the areas of all the 12 State's MPOs (exclusive of CMAP); and 5% to the State's Rural 13 14 Planning Agencies with each Agency receiving a percentage equal to its area population as it relates to the total 15 16 population to the area of all the State's Rural Planning Agencies. 17

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law. 19
