## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Revenue Law of the Civil

  Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section

  2505-305 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2505/2505-305) (was 20 ILCS 2505/39b15.1)
- 8 Sec. 2505-305. Investigators.
- 9 (a) The Department has the power to appoint investigators to conduct all investigations, searches, seizures, arrests, 10 and other duties imposed under the provisions of any law 11 12 administered by the Department. These Except as provided in subsection (c), these investigators have and may exercise all 13 14 the powers of peace officers only as provided in this Section. An investigator may exercise the powers of a peace officer 15 16 while solely for the purpose of enforcing taxing or other 17 measures administered by the Department. An investigator may exercise the powers of a peace officer when he or she discovers 18 any criminal offense or violation while enforcing any measure 19 administered by the Department, the Illinois Liquor Control 20 21 Commission, the Illinois Racing Board, or the Illinois Gaming 22 Board if (i) the criminal offense or violation creates a threat to the life or safety of the investigator or any other person 23

## and (ii) the investigator notifies the proper local law enforcement agency as soon as is practical.

- (b) The Director must authorize to each investigator employed under this Section and to any other employee of the Department exercising the powers of a peace officer a distinct badge that, on its face, (i) clearly states that the badge is authorized by the Department and (ii) contains a unique identifying number. No other badge shall be authorized by the Department.
- 10 (c) The Department may enter into agreements with the
  11 Illinois Gaming Board providing that investigators appointed
  12 under this Section shall exercise the peace officer powers set
  13 forth in paragraph (20.6) of subsection (c) of Section 5 of the
  14 Riverboat Gambling Act.
