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1	AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3215
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 3215, AS AMENDED,
3	by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4	following:
5	"Section 5. The Personnel Code is amended by changing
6	Section 4d as follows:
7	(20 ILCS 415/4d) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b104d)
8	Sec. 4d. Partial exemptions. The following positions in
9	State service are exempt from jurisdictions A, B, and C to the
10	extent stated for each, unless those jurisdictions are extended
11	as provided in this Act:
12	(1) In each department, board or commission that now
13	maintains or may hereafter maintain a major administrative
14	division, service or office in both Sangamon County and Cook
15	County, 2 private secretaries for the director or chairman
16	thereof, one located in the Cook County office and the other

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1 located in the Sangamon County office, shall be exempt from all other 2 jurisdiction B; in departments, boards and 3 commissions one private secretary for the director or chairman 4 thereof shall be exempt from jurisdiction Β. In all 5 departments, boards and commissions one confidential assistant 6 for the director or chairman thereof shall be exempt from 7 jurisdiction B. This paragraph is subject to such modifications 8 or waiver of the exemptions as may be necessary to assure the 9 continuity of federal contributions in those agencies 10 supported in whole or in part by federal funds.

11 (2) The resident administrative head of each State 12 charitable, penal and correctional institution, the chaplains 13 thereof, and all member, patient and inmate employees are 14 exempt from jurisdiction B.

15 The Civil Service Commission, upon (3) written 16 recommendation of the Director of Central Management Services, shall exempt from jurisdiction B other positions which, in the 17 the Commission, involve either 18 judgment of principal 19 administrative responsibility for the determination of policy 20 or principal administrative responsibility for the way in which policies are carried out, except positions in agencies which 21 22 receive federal funds if such exemption is inconsistent with 23 federal requirements, and except positions in agencies 24 supported in whole by federal funds.

(4) All beauticians and teachers of beauty culture andteachers of barbering, and all positions heretofore paid under

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Section 1.22 of "An Act to standardize position titles and
 salary rates", approved June 30, 1943, as amended, shall be
 exempt from jurisdiction B.

4 (5) Licensed attorneys in positions as legal or technical 5 advisors, positions in the Department of Natural Resources 6 requiring incumbents to be either a registered professional engineer or to hold a bachelor's degree in engineering from a 7 recognized college or university, licensed physicians in 8 9 positions of medical administrator or physician or physician 10 specialist (including psychiatrists), and registered nurses 11 (except those registered nurses employed by the Department of Public Health), except those in positions in agencies which 12 13 receive federal funds if such exemption is inconsistent with federal requirements and except those in positions in agencies 14 15 supported in whole by federal funds, are exempt from 16 jurisdiction B only to the extent that the requirements of Section 8b.1, 8b.3 and 8b.5 of this Code need not be met. 17

(6) All positions established outside the geographical
limits of the State of Illinois to which appointments of other
than Illinois citizens may be made are exempt from jurisdiction
B.

(7) Staff attorneys reporting directly to individual
 Commissioners of the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission
 are exempt from jurisdiction B.

25 (8) Persons (i) having specialized and advanced training
 26 and experience in information technology deployment and

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1	support, including specialized and advanced training and
2	experience in design, operation, or management of computer
3	hardware, software, telecommunications, or wide-area networks,
4	that is specifically required by the position description
5	within the bureau of the Department of Central Management
6	Services that is responsible for State information technology
7	and telecommunications systems or (ii) maintaining an
8	industry-recognized certification in information technology
9	that is specifically required by the position description
10	within the bureau of the Department of Central Management
11	Services that is responsible for State information technology
12	and telecommunications systems are exempt from jurisdiction B
13	only to the extent that the requirements of Sections 8b.1,
14	8b.3, and 8b.5 of this Code need not be met. This paragraph (8)
15	sunsets on June 30, 2013.
