1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding Section 9-121 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/9-121 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 9-121. Sealing of court file.</u>
- 8 (a) Definition. As used in this Section, "court file" means
 9 the court file created when a forcible entry and detainer
- 10 <u>action is filed with the court.</u>
- 11 (b) Discretionary sealing of court file. The court may

 12 order that a court file in a forcible entry and detainer action

 13 be placed under seal if the court finds that the plaintiff's

 14 action is sufficiently without a basis in fact or law, which

 15 may include a lack of jurisdiction, that placing the court file

 16 under seal is clearly in the interests of justice, and that
- those interests are not outweighed by the public's interest in knowing about the record.
- 19 <u>(c) Mandatory sealing of court file. The court file</u>
 20 relating to a forcible entry and detainer action brought
- 21 against a tenant who would have lawful possession of the
- 22 premises but for the foreclosure on the property shall be
- 23 sealed pursuant to Section 15-1701.

- 1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 2 becoming law.
