1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7	and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
8	of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet
9	ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
10	June 30, 2011:
11	Payable from the General Revenue Fund:
12	For Personal Services, including payment
13	to the university for personal services
14	costs incurred during the fiscal year
15	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic
16	personnel for personal services rendered

17	may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18	Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
19	for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for Excellence
20	at the Chicago campus.
21	Section 15. The sum of \$328,200, or so much thereof as
22	may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
23	Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois

- 1 for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.
- 2 Section 20. The sum of \$1,172,000, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 4 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
- 5 for costs associated with the Public Policy Institute at the
- 6 Chicago campus.
- 7 Section 25. The sum of \$328,200, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
- 10 for a grant to the College of Dentistry.
- 11 Section 30. The sum of \$2,445,500, or so much thereof as
- 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
- 13 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
- 14 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
- 15 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
- 16 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
- 17 to the University for personal services and related costs
- 18 incurred.
- 19 Section 35. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
- 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
- 21 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the

- 1 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
- 2 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.
- 3 Section 40. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
- 5 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
- 6 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
- 7 Abatement.
- 8 Section 45. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
- 10 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
- 11 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
- 12 abatement.
- 13 Section 50. The sum of \$425,000, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
- Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
- 16 and contingent expenses.
- 17 Section 55. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
- 19 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
- 20 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
- 21 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice

- education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
- 2 Rockford.
- 3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 4 2010.
