2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Section 10-160 as follows:

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(35 ILCS 200/10-160)

7 Sec. 10-160. Open space; application process. In counties with 3,000,000 or more inhabitants, the The person liable for 8 9 taxes on land used for open space purposes must file a verified application requesting the additional open space valuation 10 with the chief county assessment officer by January 31 of each 11 year for which that valuation is desired. For taxable years 12 prior to 2011, in counties with less than 3,000,000 13 14 inhabitants, the person liable for taxes on land used for open space purposes must file a verified application requesting the 15 additional open space valuation with the chief county 16 17 assessment officer by January 31 of each year for which that valuation is desired. For taxable year 2011 and thereafter, in 18 19 counties with less than 3,000,000 inhabitants, the person 20 liable for taxes on land used for open space purposes must file 21 a verified application requesting the additional open space 22 valuation with the chief county assessment officer by June 30 of each year for which that valuation is desired. If the 23

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application is not filed by January 31 or June 30, as 1 2 applicable, the taxpayer waives the right to claim that 3 additional valuation for that year. The application shall be in the form prescribed by the Department and contain information 4 5 as may reasonably be required to determine whether the applicant meets the requirements of Section 10-155. If the 6 7 application shows the applicant is entitled to the valuation, 8 chief county assessment officer shall approve it; the 9 otherwise, the application shall be rejected.

10 When such an application has been filed with and approved 11 by the chief county assessment officer, he or she shall 12 determine the valuation of the land as otherwise permitted by 13 law and as required under Section 10-155, and shall list those 14 valuations separately. The county clerk, in preparing 15 assessment books, lists and blanks under Section 9-100, shall 16 include therein columns for indicating the approval of an 17 application and for setting out the two separate valuations.
