SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 405/10.01

from Ch. 15, par. 210.01

Amends the State Comptroller Act. Provides that the Comptroller shall not draw a warrant on the treasury for an amount that is less than \$5, unless the person owed the funds makes a request, in writing, to the Office of the State Comptroller that the Comptroller draw the warrant. Provides that the Comptroller shall adopt rules to implement the requirement. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Comptroller Act is amended by changing Section 10.01 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 405/10.01) (from Ch. 15, par. 210.01)
- 7 Sec. 10.01.
- 8 <u>(a)</u> On ascertaining the amount due any person from the
- 9 treasury or from other funds held by the treasurer, the
- 10 comptroller shall draw his <u>or her</u> warrant on the treasury or on
- 11 such other funds as may be appropriate for the sum due.
- 12 Warrants shall be directed to the State Treasurer as an order
- to him or her to pay the sum due.
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- the Comptroller shall not draw a warrant on the treasury for an
- amount that is less than \$5, unless the person owed the money
- 17 makes a request, in writing, to the Office of the State
- 18 Comptroller that the Comptroller draw the warrant. Until the
- amount of the warrant equals \$5, the Comptroller shall deposit
- 20 the money into an interest-bearing account. The Comptroller
- 21 <u>shall adopt rules to implement the requirements of this</u>
- 22 subsection (b).
