Amend House Bill 1163 by replacing 3 the title with the following: 4 "AN ACT concerning firearms."; and by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 5 6 following: 7 "Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows: 8 9 (430 ILCS 65/3) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-3) 10 Sec. 3. (a) Except as provided in Section 3a, no person may 11 knowingly transfer, or cause to be transferred, any firearm, 12 firearm ammunition, stun gun, or taser to any person within this State unless the transferee with whom he deals displays a 13 14 currently valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card which has

previously been issued in his name by the Department of State

- 1 Police under the provisions of this Act. In addition, all
- 2 firearm, stun gun, and taser transfers by federally licensed
- 3 firearm dealers are subject to Section 3.1.
- 4 (a-5) Any person who is not a federally licensed firearm
- 5 dealer and who desires to transfer or sell a firearm while that
- 6 person is on the grounds of a gun show must, before selling or
- 7 transferring the firearm, request the Department of State
- 8 Police to conduct a background check on the prospective
- 9 recipient of the firearm in accordance with Section 3.1.
- 10 (b) Any person within this State who transfers or causes to
- 11 be transferred any firearm, stun gun, or taser shall keep a
- 12 record of such transfer for a period of 10 years from the date
- of transfer. Such record shall contain the date of the
- 14 transfer; the description, serial number or other information
- identifying the firearm, stun qun, or taser if no serial number
- is available; and, if the transfer was completed within this
- 17 State, the transferee's Firearm Owner's Identification Card
- number. On or after January 1, 2006, the record shall contain
- 19 the date of application for transfer of the firearm. On demand
- of a peace officer such transferor shall produce for inspection
- 21 such record of transfer. If the transfer or sale took place at
- 22 a gun show, the record shall include the unique identification
- 23 number. Failure to record the unique identification number is a
- 24 petty offense.
- 25 (b-5) Any resident may purchase ammunition from a person
- 26 <u>within or outside of Illinois if shipment is by United States</u>

- 1 mail or by a private express carrier authorized by federal law
- 2 to ship ammunition. Any resident purchasing ammunition within
- 3 or outside the State of Illinois must provide the seller with a
- 4 copy of his or her valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card
- 5 and either his or her Illinois driver's license or Illinois
- 6 State Identification Card prior to the shipment of the
- ammunition. The ammunition may be shipped only to an address on 7
- either of those 2 documents. 8
- 9 (c) The provisions of this Section regarding the transfer
- of firearm ammunition shall not apply to those persons 10
- 11 specified in paragraph (b) of Section 2 of this Act.
