Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Sections 11-214 and 11-215 as follows:

- 8 (a) Local units of government shall report to the Illinois

- 19 Sec. 11-215. Secretary of State to provide information on
- 20 <u>use of truck global positioning systems.</u>
- 21 (a) The Secretary of State shall include in its commercial
- 22 drivers license curriculum and study guide the distinctions

- 1 between utilizing a truck-attributed global positioning system
- 2 device and other non-truck-attributed global positioning
- 3 system devices.
- (b) The Secretary of State shall develop a brochure 4
- 5 regarding the distinctions between utilizing a
