12	local unit of government's jurisdiction which are not classified as Class II or Class III truck routes; and (ii) the	
13	unit of local government's designated truck route network.	
14	(b) If a local unit of government has no designated truck	
15	routes or preferred truck routes	described by subsection (a)

above, the local unit of government shall affirm to the

- 3 Sec. 11-215. Secretary of State to provide information on
- 4 use of truck global positioning systems.
- 5 (a) The Secretary of State shall include in its commercial
- drivers license curriculum and study guide the distinctions 6
- 7 between utilizing a truck-attributed global positioning system
- 8 device and other non-truck-attributed global positioning
- 9 system devices.
- 10 (b) The Secretary of State shall include the distinctions
- between utilizing a truck-attributed global positioning system 11
- 12 device and other non-truck-attributed global positioning
- 13 system devices in any documents disseminated in connection with
- 14 obtaining and renewing a commercial drivers license.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 15
- 1, 2012.". 16
