- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding Section 143.19.2 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 143.19.2. Volunteer driver protection.</u>
- (a) For the purpose of this Section, "volunteer driver" 8 9 means a person who transports by vehicle individuals or goods 10 without compensation above reimbursement for expenses, where the driving services are performed for a nationally affiliated 11 12 charitable nonprofit organization operating in Area Agencies on Aging areas number 3 or 12, as designated by the Department 13 14 on Aging, that allows older individuals to transfer their automobiles to the organization in exchange for personal 15 16 transportation services.
  - (b) An insurer may not refuse to issue vehicle insurance to a person solely because the applicant is a volunteer driver. An insurer may not impose a surcharge or otherwise increase the rate for a vehicle policy solely on the basis that the named insured or any member of the insured's household or a person who customarily operates the insured's vehicle is a volunteer driver. This Section shall not prohibit an insurer from taking
