SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/16G-25

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning an offender's interest in property obtained in the name of another person.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing

 Section 16G-25 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/16G-25)
- 7 Sec. 16G-25. Offenders interest in the property, consent.
- 8 (a) It is no defense to a charge of aggravated identity
- 9 theft or identity theft that that the offender has an interest
- in the credit, money, goods, services, or other property.
- 11 (b) It is no defense to a charge of aggravated identity
- 12 theft or identity theft that the offender received the consent
- of any person to access any personal identification information
- or personal identification document, other than the person
- 15 described by the personal identification information or
- 16 personal identification document used by the offender.
