

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by changing
5 Section 10 as follows:

6 (745 ILCS 49/10)

7 Sec. 10. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation; exemption from
8 civil liability for emergency care. Any person trained
9 ~~currently certified~~ in basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation who
10 has successfully completed training in accordance with the
11 standards of the American Red Cross or the American Heart
12 Association and ~~complies with generally recognized standards,~~
13 ~~and~~ who in good faith, not for compensation, provides emergency
14 cardiopulmonary resuscitation in accordance with his or her
15 training to a person who is an apparent victim of acute
16 cardiopulmonary insufficiency shall not, as the result of his
17 or her acts or omissions in providing resuscitation, be liable
18 for civil damages, unless the acts or omissions constitute
19 willful and wanton misconduct.
