SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.45 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that each school board shall require at least 60 minutes of reading instruction per day for any student whose reading level is one grade level or lower than his or her current grade level according to current learning standards and the school district. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.53 and 34-18.45 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.53 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.53. Minimum reading instruction. Each school
8 board shall require at least 60 minutes of reading instruction
9 per day for any student whose reading level is one grade level
10 or lower than his or her current grade level according to
11 current learning standards and the school district.

12 (105 ILCS 5/34-18.45 new)

13 Sec. 34-18.45. Minimum reading instruction. The board
14 shall require at least 60 minutes of reading instruction per
15 day for any student whose reading level is one grade level or
16 lower than his or her current grade level according to current
17 learning standards and the school district.

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
19 becoming law.
