1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding Section 11-6-1.2 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-6-1.2 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 11-6-1.2. Fee for emergency fire and rescue services.</u>
- 8 (a) The corporate authorities of a municipality may fix,
 9 charge, and collect fees not exceeding the reasonable cost of
 10 the service for all services rendered by the fire department of
- 11 the municipality against persons, businesses, and other
- entities who are not residents of the municipality.
- 13 (b) The fee may not be assessed against residents of the
- 14 <u>municipality or persons who request fire protection coverage</u>
- for an unprotected area and pay to the municipality an amount
- 16 <u>equal to the municipality's fire protection tax levied pursuant</u>
- 17 <u>to Section 11-7-1.</u>
- 18 (c) The fee shall be computed at a rate not to exceed \$250
- 19 per hour for emergency assistance. An additional charge may be
- 20 levied to reimburse the municipality for extraordinary
- 21 expenses of materials used in rendering such emergency fire and
- 22 rescue services. No fee shall be imposed for fire and rescue
- 23 services for which the total cost is less than \$50. These fee

- <u>limitations</u> shall not apply to ambulance services, and those 1
- 2 services may be billed separately.
- (d) All revenue from the fees assessed pursuant to this 3
- Section shall be deposited into the general fund of the 4
- 5 municipality.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
