SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-25027 new 405 ILCS 20/14 new

Amends the Counties Code. Requires the county board chairman in every county with a population of less than 3,000,000 to appoint, no later that December 31, 2011, a volunteer 7 member mental health advisory committee composed of members of the general public, if the county has established a county health department, but no mental health program has been approved as provided under the Act. Amends the Community Mental Health Act. Requires the county board chairman in every county with a population of less than 3,000,000, or the township supervisor of a township located in a county with a population of 3,000,000 or more, to appoint, no later that December 31, 2011, a volunteer 7 member mental health advisory committee composed of members of the general public, if no community mental health board has been established in the county or township as provided under the Act. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
5-25027 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 5-25027. Advisory committee.</u>

(a) No later than December 31, 2011, the county board 8 9 chairman in every county with a population of less than 3,000,000 shall appoint a volunteer 7 member mental health 10 advisory committee composed of members of the general public, 11 12 if the county has established a county health department pursuant to this Act, but no mental health program has been 13 14 approved by the county health department as provided in Section 5-25025 of this Act. 15

16 <u>(b) The mental health advisory committee shall identify and</u> 17 <u>assess current mental health services in its respective</u> 18 <u>jurisdiction, monitor any expansion or contraction of such</u> 19 <u>services, and, if deemed necessary, provide a report to the</u> 20 <u>county board with recommendations for additional services.</u>

21 (c) The mental health advisory committee shall have no 22 taxing authority.

23 (d) This Section is repealed on December 31, 2018.

1 Section 10. The Community Mental Health Act is amended by adding Section 14 as follows: 2 3 (405 ILCS 20/14 new) 4 Sec. 14. Advisory committee. (a) No later than December 31, 2011, the county board 5 chairman in every county with a population of less than 6 7 3,000,000, or the township supervisor of a township located in a county with a population of 3,000,000 or more, shall appoint 8 9 a volunteer 7 member mental health advisory committee composed 10 of members of the general public, if no community mental health 11 board has been established in the county or township as 12 provided under Section 3a of this Act. 13 (b) The mental health advisory committee shall identify and 14 assess current mental health services in its respective 15 jurisdiction, monitor any expansion or contraction of such 16 services, and, if deemed necessary, provide a report to the county or township board with recommendations for additional 17 18 services. (c) The mental health advisory committee shall have no 19 20 taxing authority. 21 (d) This Section is repealed on December 31, 2018. 22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23 becoming law.
