- (a) No later than December 31, 2011, the county board 5
- chairman in every county with a population of less than 6
- 7 3,000,000, or the township supervisor of a township located in
- a county with a population of 3,000,000 or more, shall appoint 8
- 9 a volunteer 7 member mental health advisory committee composed
- 10 of members of the general public, if no community mental health
- board has been established in the county or township as 11
- provided under Section 3a of this Act. This subsection shall 12
- not apply to townships that currently provide mental health 13
- 14 services.
- 15 (b) The mental health advisory committee shall identify and
- assess current mental health services in its respective 16
