9 (a) No later than December 31, 2011, the county board chairman in every county with a population of less than 10 11 3,000,000, or the township supervisor of a township located in a county with a population of 3,000,000 or more, shall appoint 12 a volunteer 7 member mental health advisory committee composed 13 14 of members of the general public, if no community mental health board has been established in the county or township as 15 16 provided under Section 3a of this Act. This subsection shall 17 not apply to townships that currently monitor and address mental health needs of township residents by providing or 18 19 funding <del>provide</del> mental health services available to 20 individuals and families, and that include the following: 21 psychiatric evaluation, therapy, crisis assessment and 22 intervention, and case management.

(b) The mental health advisory committee shall identify and
