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Section 50. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention 8 Division Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 9 assistance to firefighters grant for smoke detectors for the 10 11 deaf and hard of hearing.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 12 13 2011.
