1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 9-101 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/9-101) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 9-101)
- 7 Sec. 9-101. All rates or other charges made, demanded or
- 8 received by any product or commodity furnished or to be
- 9 furnished or for any service rendered or to be rendered shall
- 10 be just <u>and</u> reasonable. Every unjust or unreasonable charge
- 11 made, demanded or received for such product or commodity or
- 12 service is hereby prohibited and declared unlawful. All rules
- 13 and regulations made by a public utility affecting or
- 14 pertaining to its charges to the public shall be just and
- 15 reasonable.
