Amends the Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the short title and policy of the Act.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 15/1) (from Ch. 111, par. 5351)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2017)
- Sec. 1. The The practice of clinical psychology in Illinois 8 is hereby declared to affect the public health, safety and welfare, and to be subject to regulations in the public 10 11 interest to protect the public from persons 12 unauthorized or unqualified to represent themselves clinical psychologists or as being able to render clinical 13 14 psychological services herein defined, and as unprofessional conduct by persons licensed to 15 practice
- 16 clinical psychology. This Act shall be known and may be cited
- 17 as the "Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act".
