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1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2562
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 2562 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by
5	changing Section 3 as follows:
6	(50 ILCS 705/3) (from Ch. 85, par. 503)
7	Sec. 3. Board - composition - appointments - tenure -
8	vacancies. The Board shall be composed of 19 members selected
9	as follows: The Attorney General of the State of Illinois, the
10	Director of State Police, the Director of Corrections, the
11	Superintendent of the Chicago Police Department, the Sheriff of
12	Cook County, the Director of the Illinois Police Training
13	Institute, the Special Agent in Charge of the Springfield,
14	Illinois, division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the
15	Executive Director of the Illinois Board of Higher Education
16	and the following to be appointed by the Governor: 2 mayors or

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1 village presidents of Illinois municipalities, one 2 Illinois 2 county sheriff sheriffs from a county counties other than Cook County, 2 managers of Illinois municipalities, $\frac{2}{3}$ chiefs of 3 4 municipal police departments in Illinois having no 5 Superintendent of the Police Department on the Board, and 2 6 citizens of Illinois who shall be members of an organized enforcement officers' association which has no other members on 7 the Board other than the chief of a municipal police 8 9 department, the Special Agent of the Federal Bureau of 10 Investigation, the Director of State Police, a county sheriff 11 or deputy sheriff, and one active member of a statewide association representing sheriffs and one active member of a 12 13 statewide association representing municipal police chiefs, 14 each to be appointed by the President of his or her respective 15 association. The appointments of the Governor shall be made on 16 the first Monday of August in 1965 with 3 of the appointments to be for a period of one year, 3 for 2 years, and 3 for 3 17 years. Their successors shall be appointed in like manner for 18 terms to expire the first Monday of August each 3 years 19 20 thereafter. All members shall serve until their respective 21 successors are appointed and qualify. Vacancies shall be filled 22 by the Governor for the unexpired terms.
