1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The School Safety Drill Act is amended by 5 changing Section 25 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 128/25)

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Sec. 25. Annual review.

(a) Each public school district, through its school board 8 9 or the board's designee, shall conduct a minimum of one annual meeting at which it will review each school building's 10 emergency and crisis response plans, protocols, and procedures 11 and each building's compliance with the school safety drill 12 13 programs. The purpose of this annual review shall be to review 14 and update the emergency and crisis response plans, protocols, and procedures and the school safety drill programs of the 15 16 district and each of its school buildings.

17 (b) Each school board or the board's designee is required 18 to participate in the annual review and to invite each of the 19 following parties to the annual review and provide each party 20 with a minimum of 30-days' notice before the date of the annual 21 review:

(1) The principal of each school within the schooldistrict or his or her official designee.

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1 (2) Representatives from any other education-related 2 organization or association deemed appropriate by the 3 school district.

4 (3) Representatives from all local first responder
5 organizations to participate, advise, and consult in the
6 review process, including, but not limited to:

7 (A) the appropriate local fire department or
8 district;

(B) the appropriate local law enforcement agency;

10 (C) the appropriate local emergency medical 11 services agency if the agency is a separate, local 12 first responder unit; and

(D) any other member of the first responder or emergency management community that has contacted the district superintendent or his or her designee during the past year to request involvement in a school's emergency planning or drill process.

(4) The school board or its designee may also choose to
invite to the annual review any other persons whom it
believes will aid in the review process, including, but not
limited to, any members of any other education-related
organization or the first responder or emergency
management community.

(c) Upon the conclusion of the annual review, the school board or the board's designee shall sign a one page report, which may be in either a check-off format or a narrative 1 format, that does the following:

2 (1) summarizes the review's recommended changes to the
3 existing school safety plans and drill plans;

4 (2) lists the parties that participated in the annual
5 review, and includes the annual review's attendance
6 record;

- 7 (3) certifies that an effective review of the emergency
 8 and crisis response plans, protocols, and procedures and
 9 the school safety drill programs of the district and each
 10 of its school buildings has occurred;
- (4) states that the school district will implement those plans, protocols, procedures, and programs, during the academic year; and
- 14 (5) includes the authorization of the school board or 15 the board's designee<u>;</u>.

16 (6) reports any renovation or addition to a school 17 building or a change in the floor plan of a school 18 building; and

19 <u>(7) acknowledges that there has been submission of a</u> 20 <u>change in floor plans to the local fire department or local</u> 21 <u>law enforcement agency as provided under subsection (f) of</u> 22 <u>this Section.</u>

(d) The school board or its designee shall send a copy of the report to each party that participates in the annual review process and to the appropriate regional superintendent of schools. If any of the participating parties have comments on HB3040 Engrossed - 4 - LRB097 08715 NHT 48844 b

the certification document, those parties shall submit their 1 writing to 2 comments in the appropriate regional superintendent. The regional superintendent shall maintain a 3 record of these comments. The certification document may be in 4 5 a check-off format or narrative format, at the discretion of 6 the district superintendent.

7 (e) The review must occur at least once during the fiscal
8 year, at a specific time chosen at the school district
9 superintendent's discretion.

10 (f) Upon completion of any renovation or addition to a 11 school building or a change in the floor plan of a school 12 building that modifies a previously approved emergency and 13 crisis response plan at least 60 days prior to the meeting 14 required under subsection (a) of this Section, the school board or its designee shall contact the local fire department and 15 16 local law enforcement agency to set up a meeting to review any 17 changes in procedures and protocols affected by building modifications as a result of renovations, additions, or changes 18 19 in floor plans.
