

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB3106

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/2-3002.5

Amends the Counties Code. Provides that beginning with members elected at the general election in 2002, counties having a population between 800,000 and 3,000,000 according to the most recent federal (previously, 2000) decennial census shall have no more than 18 members on their county board. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section 2-3002.5 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/2-3002.5)
- 7 Sec. 2-3002.5. Beginning with members elected at 8 general election in 2002, counties having a population between 9 800,000 and 3,000,000 according to the most recent federal $\frac{2000}{1000}$ decennial census shall have no more than 18 members on their 10 county board. If the chairman of the county board is elected 11 at-large by the voters of the county as provided in Section 12 2-3007, the chairman shall not be counted as a member of the 13 14 county board for the purpose of the limitations on the size of the county board provided in this Section. Neither a member nor 15 16 the chairman of that county board shall serve simultaneously as 17 commissioner or president of the board of commissioners of the forest preserve district. No person shall seek election to both 18 19 the county board and the forest preserve commission at the same 20 election.
