2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 3115 as follows:
3	on page 2, line 9, by replacing " <u>secular</u> " with " <u>selected</u> "; and
4	on page 2, line 10, after " <u>textbooks.</u> ", by inserting " <u>The</u>
5	textbooks authorized to be purchased under this Section are
6	limited without exception to textbooks that have been
7	preapproved and designated by the State Board of Education for
8	use in any public school and that are secular, non-religious,
9	and non-sectarian. The State Board of Education shall annually
10	publish a list of the textbooks authorized to be purchased
11	under this Section."; and
12	on page 2, line 18, after " <u>Section</u> ", by inserting " <u>and to</u>
13	ensure the religious neutrality of the textbook block grant
14	program, as well as provide for the monitoring of all textbooks
15	authorized in this Section to be purchased directly by

State-recognized, nonpublic schools serving students in grades
<u>kindergarten through 12</u>".
