handguns of .30 caliber or larger with a minimum barrel length of 4 inches. The only legal ammunition for a centerfire handgun is a cartridge of .30 caliber or larger with a capability of at least 500 foot pounds of energy at the muzzle. Full metal jacket bullets may not be used to harvest deer.

6 The Department shall make administrative rules concerning 7 management restrictions applicable to the firearm and bow and 8 arrow season.

9 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except 10 with a bow and arrow, or crossbow device for handicapped 11 persons, as defined in Section 2.33, and persons age 62 or 12 older during the open season for bow and arrow set annually by 13 the Director between the dates of September 1st and January 14 31st, both inclusive.

15 It shall be unlawful for any person to take deer except 16 with (i) a muzzleloading rifle, or (ii) bow and arrow, or 17 crossbow device for handicapped persons, as defined in Section 18 2.33, and persons age 62 or older during the open season for 19 muzzleloading rifles set annually by the Director.

The Director shall cause an administrative rule setting forth the prescribed rules and regulations, including bag and possession limits and those counties of the State where open seasons are established, to be published in accordance with Sections 1.3 and 1.13 of this Act.

found in the deer herd. This season shall be restricted to gun or bow and arrow hunting only. The Department shall publicly announce, via statewide news release, the season dates and shooting hours, the counties and sites open to hunting, permit requirements, application dates, hunting rules, legal weapons, and reporting requirements.

7 The Department is authorized to establish a separate 8 harvest period at specific sites within the State for the 9 purpose of harvesting surplus deer that cannot be taken during 10 the regular season provided for the taking of deer. This season 11 shall be restricted to gun or bow and arrow hunting only and shall be established during the period of September 1st to 12 13 February 15th, both inclusive with a minimum of 3 days of the 14 season occurring between December 25th and December 31st. The 15 Department shall publish suitable prescribed rules and 16 regulations established by administrative rule pertaining to management restrictions applicable to this special harvest 17 program. The Department shall allow unused gun deer permits 18 19 that are left over from a regular season for the taking of deer 20 to be rolled over and used during any separate harvest period held within 6 months of the season for which those tags were 21 22 issued at no additional cost to the permit holder subject to 23 the management restrictions applicable to the special harvest 24 program.
