215 ILCS 5/143.19c new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that no policy of automobile insurance may be cancelled where the basis for such cancellation is the insured's lack of a valid drivers license or valid instruction permit if the insurer failed to ask the insured for proof of a valid drivers license or valid instruction permit at the time the insured applied for coverage.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding
Section 143.19c as follows:

(215 ILCS 5/143.19c new) 6 7 Sec. 143.19c. Cancellation; valid drivers license. No 8 policy of insurance as defined in subsection (a) of Section 9 143.13 of this Act may be cancelled where the basis for such cancellation is the insured's lack of a valid drivers license 10 or valid instruction permit if the insurer failed to ask the 11 insured for proof of a valid drivers license or valid 12 instruction permit at the time the insured applied for 13 14 coverage.
