SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 335/2 50 ILCS 122/10 from Ch. 127, par. 4052

Amends the Disaster Service Volunteer Leave Act and the Local Government Disaster Service Volunteer Act. Provides that "disaster" includes any disaster declared by proclamation of the Governor under a specific provision of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act. Effective immediately.

- 5 corporate of local governments as defined in the Counties Code,
- 6 Township Code, and Illinois Municipal Code.
- 7 "Disaster" includes (i) disasters designated at Level III
- 8 and above in the American National Red Cross Regulations and
- 9 Procedures and (ii) any disaster declared by a proclamation of
- 10 the Governor under Section 7 of the Illinois Emergency
- Management Agency Act.
