1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3700

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3700, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
4 following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The sum of \$38,697,400, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
8 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
9 University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal
10 year ending June 30, 2012.

11 Section 10. The sum of \$104,400, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State

1 University for awards and grants to students for the fiscal
2 year ending June 30, 2012.

3 Section 15. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
5 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
6 University for all costs associated with the Financial
7 Assistance Outreach Center.

8 Section 20. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
10 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
11 Chicago State University for all costs associated with the
12 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
13 education or training programs.

 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 21 Assistance Fund to the Board of the Trustees of the
 22 University of Illinois to meet its operational expenses for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

2 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
4 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
5 of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet
6 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
7 June 30, 2012:

12 Section 15. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
14 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
15 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for
16 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$328,300, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
19 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
20 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

21 Section 25. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
2 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
3 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy
4 Institute at the Chicago campus.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
8 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

9 Section 35. The sum of \$3,331,200, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
11 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
12 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
13 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
14 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
15 to the University for personal services and related costs
16 incurred.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
19 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
20 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
21 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

1 Section 45. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
3 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
4 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
5 Abatement.

6 Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
8 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
9 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
10 abatement.

11 Section 55. The sum of \$425,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
13 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
14 and contingent expenses.

15 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
17 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
18 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
19 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
20 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
21 Rockford.

2 Section 5. The sum of \$55,604,300, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to Board of the Trustees of Western Illinois
5 University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal
6 year ending June 30, 2012.

7 Section 10. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
9 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western
10 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the
11 sale of collegiate license plates.

12 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect
13 July 1, 2011."
