SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 155/10

Amends the Long Term Acute Care Hospital Quality Improvement Transfer Program Act to include in the definition of "LTAC hospital" a hospital that begins operations after January 1, 2009 (instead of 2010) and is designated by Medicare as a long term acute care hospital. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning health facilities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Long Term Acute Care Hospital Quality
Improvement Transfer Program Act is amended by changing Section
10 as follows:

7 (210 ILCS 155/10)

8 Sec. 10. Definitions. As used in this Act:

9 (a) "CARE tool" means the Continuity and Record Evaluation (CARE) tool. It is a patient assessment instrument that has 10 been developed to document the medical, cognitive, functional, 11 and discharge status of persons receiving health care services 12 13 in acute and post-acute care settings. The data collected is 14 able to document provider-level quality of care (patient clinical 15 outcomes) and characterize the complexity of 16 patients.

17 (b) "Department" means the Illinois Department of18 Healthcare and Family Services.

19 (c) "Discharge" means the release of a patient from 20 hospital care for any discharge disposition other than a leave 21 of absence, even if for Medicare payment purposes the discharge 22 fits the definition of an interrupted stay.

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(d) "FTE" means "full-time equivalent" or a person or

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1 persons employed in one full-time position.

(e) "Hospital" means an institution, place, building, or
agency located in this State that is licensed as a general
acute hospital by the Illinois Department of Public Health
under the Hospital Licensing Act, whether public or private and
whether organized for profit or not-for-profit.

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(f) "ICU" means intensive care unit.

8 (q) "LTAC hospital" means a hospital that is designated by 9 Medicare as a long term acute care hospital as described in 10 Section 1886(d)(1)(B)(iv)(I) of the Social Security Act and has 11 an average length of Medicaid inpatient stay greater than 25 12 days as reported on the hospital's 2008 Medicaid cost report on 13 file as of February 15, 2010, or a hospital that begins operations after January 1, 2009 2010 and is designated by 14 15 Medicare as a long term acute care hospital.

16 (h) "LTAC hospital criteria" means nationally recognized 17 evidence-based evaluation criteria that have been publicly tested and includes criteria specific to an LTAC hospital for 18 19 admission, continuing stay, and discharge. The criteria cannot 20 include criteria derived or developed by or for a specific hospital or group of hospitals. Criteria and tools developed by 21 22 hospitals hospital associations or hospital-owned or 23 are not acceptable do organizations and not meet the 24 requirements of this subsection.

(i) "Patient" means an individual who is admitted to ahospital for an inpatient stay.

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(j) "Program" means the Long Term Acute Care Hospital
 Quality Improvement Transfer Program established by this Act.

3 (k) "STAC hospital" means a hospital that is not an LTAC 4 hospital as defined in this Act or a psychiatric hospital or a 5 rehabilitation hospital.
