

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB3845

Introduced 10/19/2011, by Rep. Kelly M. Cassidy

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-1134 new 65 ILCS 5/11-1-12 new 30 ILCS 805/8.35 new

Amends the Counties Code and the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a county or municipality, as applicable, shall establish a program that allows individuals to turn in any unwanted firearms by calling the local police department to set up a time to turn the firearm in at the police station. Limits the concurrent exercise of home rule powers. Amends the State Mandates Act. Requires implementation without reimbursement.

- 8 Section 8.35 as follows:

- Sec. 8.35. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
- the 97th General Assembly.
