

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB3888

Introduced 11/28/2011, by Rep. JoAnn D. Osmond

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 45/5-23 new

Amends the Boat Registration and Safety Act. Provides that no person may place or operate a vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object of any kind in waters of this State if it has any aquatic plants or aquatic animals attached to the exterior of the vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object. Provides that no person may take off with a seaplane, or transport or operate a vehicle, watercraft, or other object of any kind on a highway with aquatic plants or aquatic animals attached to the exterior of the seaplane, vehicle, watercraft, or other object. Provides exceptions. Provides that a person must comply with instructions given by a law enforcement officer who has reason to believe that the person is in violation of the new provisions. Provides that the Department of Natural Resources shall produce and make copies available of a notice containing a summary of the new provisions and that owners of boat access sites must post and maintain a copy of the notice.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Boat Registration and Safety Act is amended by adding Section 5-23 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 45/5-23 new)
- Sec. 5-23. Transportation of aquatic plants and animals;

  8 placement of objects in navigable waters.
- 9 (a) No person may place or operate a vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object of any kind in waters of this State 10 if it has any aquatic plants or aquatic animals attached to the 11 12 exterior of the vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object. This Section does not require a person to remove aquatic plants 13 14 or aquatic animals from a vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object during the period of time when the vehicle, 15 16 seaplane, watercraft, or other object is being operated in the same navigable body of water in which the aquatic plants or 17 aquatic animals became attached. 18
  - (b) No person may take off with a seaplane, or transport or operate a vehicle, watercraft, or other object of any kind on a highway with aquatic plants or aquatic animals attached to the exterior of the seaplane, vehicle, watercraft, or other object.
- 23 <u>(c) A law enforcement officer who has reason to believe</u>

1	that a person is in violation of this Section may order the
2	person to:
3	(i) remove aquatic plants or aquatic animals from a
4	vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object of any kind
5	before placing it in a navigable water;
6	(ii) remove aquatic plants or aquatic animals from a
7	seaplane before taking off with the seaplane;
8	(iii) remove from, or not place in, a navigable water,
9	a vehicle, seaplane, watercraft, or other object of any
10	kind; or
11	(iv) not take off with a seaplane, or transport or
12	operate a vehicle, watercraft, or other object of any kind
13	on a highway.
14	(d) No person may refuse to obey the order of a law
15	enforcement officer acting under subsection (c) of this
16	Section.
17	(e) This Section does not prohibit a person from:
18	(i) transporting or operating a vehicle, seaplane,
19	watercraft, or other object of any kind with duckweed that
20	is incidentally attached to the exterior of the vehicle,
21	seaplane, watercraft, or other object; or
22	(ii) transporting or operating commercial aquatic
23	plant harvesting equipment that has aquatic plants or
24	animals attached to the exterior of the equipment, if the
25	equipment is owned or operated by a local governmental
26	unit, is being transported or operated for the purpose of

- (f) The Department shall prepare a notice that contains a summary of the provisions under this Section and shall make copies of the notice available to persons required to post the notice under subsection (g) of this Section.
- 9 maintain the notice described in subsection (f) of this
  10 Section. For purposes of this Section, a "public boat access
  11 site" means a site that provides access to a navigable water
  12 for boats and that is open to the general public for free or
  13 for a charge or that is open only to certain groups of persons
  14 for a charge.
