SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/8.25c

from Ch. 127, par. 144.25c

Amends the State Finance Act. Provides that, continuing through the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012 (rather than, until the sum of \$31,200,000 is paid to the General Revenue Fund), the State Comptroller shall order transferred and the State Treasurer shall transfer from the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund to the General Revenue Fund 35% of revenue deposited into the Adeline Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund in any fiscal year. Provides that, continuing through the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012 (rather than, until the sum of \$8,000,000 is paid to the State Boating Act Fund), the State Comptroller shall order transferred and the State Treasurer shall transfer from the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund to the State Boating Act Fund), the State Boating Act Fund 15% of the revenue deposited into the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund to the State Boating Act Fund 15% of the revenue deposited into the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by changing
Section 8.25c as follows:

7 8.25c. (a) Beginning in fiscal year 1991 Sec. and continuing through the third quarter of fiscal year 1993, the 8 State Comptroller shall order transferred and the State 9 10 Treasurer shall transfer from the Illinois Beach Marina Fund (now known as the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina 11 Fund) to the General Revenue Fund 50% of the revenue deposited 12 13 into the Illinois Beach Marina Fund. Beginning in the fourth 14 quarter of fiscal year 1993 and continuing through the fourth guarter of fiscal year 2012 thereafter until the sum of 15 16 \$31,200,000 is paid to the General Revenue Fund, the State 17 Comptroller shall order transferred and the State Treasurer shall transfer from the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach 18 Marina Fund (formerly known as the Illinois Beach Marina Fund) 19 to the General Revenue Fund 35% of revenue deposited into the 20 21 Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund (formerly 22 known as the Illinois Beach Marina Fund) in any fiscal year. In addition, beginning in fiscal year 1991 and continuing through 23

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the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012, thereafter until the 1 2 sum of \$8,000,000 is paid to the State Boating Act Fund the State Comptroller shall order transferred and the State 3 Treasurer shall transfer from the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis 4 5 Illinois Beach Marina Fund (formerly known as the Illinois 6 Beach Marina Fund) to the State Boating Act Fund 15% of the revenue deposited into the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach 7 8 Marina Fund (formerly known as the Illinois Beach Marina Fund). 9 Beginning in fiscal year 1992, the transfers from the Adeline 10 Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund (formerly known as the 11 Illinois Beach Marina Fund) to the State Boating Act Fund shall 12 be made only at the direction of and in the amount authorized by the Department of Natural Resources. Moneys transferred 13 under authorization of this Section to the State Boating Act 14 Fund in fiscal year 1992 before the effective date of this 15 16 amendatory Act of 1991 may be transferred to the Illinois Beach 17 Marina Fund (now known as the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund) at the direction of the Department of 18 Natural Resources. The transfers required under this Section 19 20 shall be made within 30 days after the end of each quarter based on the State Comptroller's record of receipts for the 21 22 quarter. The initial transfers shall be made within 30 days 23 after June 30, 1990 based on revenues received in the preceding 24 guarter. Additional transfers in excess of the limits 25 established under this Section may be authorized by the 26 Department of Natural Resources for accelerated payback of the

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1 amount due.

(b) The Department may, subject to appropriations by the General Assembly, use moneys in the Adeline Jay Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina Fund (formerly known as the Illinois Beach Marina Fund) to pay for operation, maintenance, repairs, or improvements to the marina project; provided, however, that payment of the amounts due under the terms of subsection (a) shall have priority on all moneys deposited in this Fund.

9 (c) Moneys on deposit in excess of that needed for payments 10 to the General Revenue Fund and the State Boating Act Fund and 11 in excess of those moneys needed for the operation, 12 maintenance, repairs, or improvements to the Adeline Jay 13 Geo-Karis Illinois Beach Marina as determined by the Department of Natural Resources may be transferred at the discretion of 14 15 the Department to the State Parks Fund.
