## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Plumbing License Law is amended by
changing Section 35 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 320/35) (from Ch. 111, par. 1133)

7 Sec. 35. The Department shall promulgate and publish and may from time to time amend a minimum code of standards for 8 9 plumbing and the fixtures, materials, design and installation 10 methods of plumbing systems based upon the findings of the sciences of pneumatics and hydraulics, after consideration of 11 the recommendations of the Plumbing Code Advisory Council. By 12 January 1, 2013, the <u>Plumbing Code Advisory Council shall</u> 13 14 recommend amendments to the existing minimum code of standards for plumbing and the fixtures, materials, design, and 15 installation methods of plumbing systems to reflect advances in 16 17 those technologies and methods that more efficiently utilize natural resources and protect public health. 18 Upon 19 consideration of those recommendations, the Department shall 20 submit the amendments to the existing minimum code of standards 21 to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules by May 31, 2013. 22 The Department may promulgate and publish rules in the State's minimum code of standards for the minimum number of plumbing 23

fixtures required for the comfort and convenience of workers 1 2 and the public not inconsistent with, but not limited to, the 3 requirements of the federal Americans With Disabilities Act, the Equitable Restrooms Act, and the U.S. Department of Labor, 4 5 Office of Safety and Health Administration. The minimum code of standards for plumbing and any amendments thereto shall be 6 7 filed with the Secretary of State as a public record. In 8 preparing plumbing code standards and amendments thereto the 9 Department may give consideration to the recommendations 10 contained in nationally recognized plumbing codes and 11 recommendations of nationally recognized material and 12 equipment testing laboratories. The plumbing code promulgated 13 by the Department under authority of this Act shall remain in 14 effect as the minimum code authorized by this Act until the 15 Department promulgates a new code under authority of this Act. 16 At least 20 days' notice of a public hearing shall be given by 17 the Department in a manner which the Department considers adequate to bring the hearing to the attention of persons 18 19 interested in plumbing code standards. Notice of any public 20 hearing shall be given by the Department to those who file a request for a notice of hearings. 21
