- 7 Sec. 1-4. Pleadings.) On the the court's own motion or on
- 8 motion of any interested person, before or during any hearing,
- 9 any person who desires to oppose the entry of an order or
- 10 judgment shall file, as directed by the court, a pleading
- disclosing the grounds of opposition.
