1 and the President and the minority leader of the Senate, 2 the majority leader \$16,000 each; in the House of Representatives \$13,500; 6 assistant majority leaders and 5 3 4 assistant minority leaders in the Senate, \$12,000 each; 6 5 assistant majority leaders and 6 assistant minority leaders in 6 the House of Representatives, \$10,500 each; 2 Deputy Majority leaders in the House of Representatives, \$11,500 each; and 2 7 Deputy Minority leaders in the House of Representatives, 8 9 \$11,500 each; the majority caucus chairman and minority caucus 10 chairman in the Senate, \$12,000 each; and beginning the second 11 Wednesday in January, 1989, the majority conference chairman and the minority conference chairman in the House 12 of 13 Representatives, \$10,500 each; beginning the second Wednesday 14 in January, 1989, and through the second Tuesday in January, 15 2013, the chairman and minority spokesman of each standing 16 committee of the Senate, except the Rules Committee, the Committee on Committees, and the Committee on Assignment of 17 Bills, \$6,000 each; and beginning the second Wednesday in 18 January, 1989, and through the second Tuesday in January, 2013, 19 20 the chairman and minority spokesman of each standing and select 21 committee of the House of Representatives, \$6,000 each. 22 Beginning on the second Wednesday in January, 2013, the chairmen and minority spokesmen of standing committees in the 23 24 Senate and the House of Representatives shall not receive 25 additional compensation for service in that capacity. A member 26 who serves in more than one position as an officer, caucus

1 committee chairman, or conference chairman committee minority spokesman shall receive only one additional amount based on the 2 3 position paying the highest additional amount. The 4 compensation provided for in this Section to be paid per year 5 to members of the General Assembly, including the additional 6 sums payable per year to officers of the General Assembly shall be paid in 12 equal monthly installments. The first such 7 installment is payable on January 31, 1977. All subsequent 8 9 equal monthly installments are payable on the last working day 10 of the month. A member who has held office any part of a month 11 is entitled to compensation for an entire month.

Mileage shall be paid at the rate of 20 cents per mile 12 before January 9, 1985, and at the mileage allowance rate in 13 14 effect under regulations promulgated pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 15 5707(b)(2) beginning January 9, 1985, for the number of actual 16 highway miles necessarily and conveniently traveled by the most feasible route to be present upon convening of the sessions of 17 the General Assembly by such member in each and every trip 18 during each session in going to and returning from the seat of 19 20 government, to be computed by the Comptroller. A member 21 traveling by public transportation for such purposes, however, 22 shall be paid his actual cost of that transportation instead of 23 on the mileage rate if his cost of public transportation 24 exceeds the amount to which he would be entitled on a mileage 25 basis. 1 trip for each week the General Assembly is actually in session. 2 Each member shall also receive an allowance of \$36 per day for lodging and meals while in attendance at sessions of the 3 4 General Assembly before January 9, 1985; beginning January 9, 5 1985, such food and lodging allowance shall be equal to the 6 amount per day permitted to be deducted for such expenses under the Internal Revenue Code; however, beginning May 31, 1995, no 7 allowance for food and lodging while in attendance at sessions 8 9 is authorized for periods of time after the last day in May of 10 each calendar year, except (i) if the General Assembly is 11 convened in special session by either the Governor or the presiding officers of both houses, as provided by subsection 12 13 (b) of Section 5 of Article IV of the Illinois Constitution or (ii) if the General Assembly is convened to consider bills 14 15 item vetoed, reduced, or returned with specific vetoed, 16 recommendations for change by the Governor as provided in Section 9 of Article IV of the Illinois Constitution. 17 Notwithstanding any other provision, for fiscal year 2011 and 18 for session days in fiscal year 2012 only (i) the allowance for 19 20 lodging and meals is \$111 per day and (ii) mileage for automobile travel shall be reimbursed at a rate of \$0.39 per 21 22 mile.

Board, except that fiscal year 2012 mileage reimbursement is
set at a rate of \$0.39 per mile.

If a member dies having received only a portion of the amount payable as compensation, the unpaid balance shall be paid to the surviving spouse of such member, or, if there be none, to the estate of such member.
