SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/12-4.40

Amends the Administration Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall contract (rather than is authorized to contract) with third-party entities to conduct Payment Recapture Audits to detect and recapture payments made in error or as a result of fraud or abuse. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Section 12-4.40 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/12-4.40)

- Sec. 12-4.40. Payment Recapture Audits. The Department of Healthcare and Family Services <u>shall</u> is authorized to contract with third-party entities to conduct Payment Recapture Audits to detect and recapture payments made in error or as a result of fraud or abuse. Payment Recapture Audits under this Section may be performed in conjunction with similar audits performed under federal authorization.
- A Payment Recapture Audit shall include the process of identifying improper payments paid to providers or other entities whereby accounting specialists and fraud examination specialists examine payment records and uncover such problems as duplicate payments, payments for services not rendered, overpayments, payments for unauthorized services, and fictitious vendors. This audit may include the use of professional and specialized auditors on a contingency basis, with compensation tied to the identification of misspent funds.
