1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6114

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6114, by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
8 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

3 Section 5. The sum of \$357,750, or so much thereof as
 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
 5 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and
 6 expenses related to or in support of a public safety shared
 7 services center.

8 Section 10. The sum of \$65,000, or so much thereof as
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
 10 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and
 11 expenses related to or in support of the Fire Explorer and
 12 Cadet School.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
 15 Firefighters' Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire
 16 Marshal for expenses related to the maintenance of the
 17 Illinois Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen
 18 Firefighter Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under
 19 Public Act 91-0832.

20 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much
 21 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

1 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

2 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

3 For Expenses of senior officer training55,000

4 For Expenses of the Risk Watch/Remember

5 When program10,000

6 For Expenses related to fire prevention training25,000

7 For Expenses of Firefighter Testing

8 and Training Audits150,000

9 Payable from the Fire Prevention Division Fund:

10 For Expenses of the U.S. Resource

11 Conservation and Recovery Act

12 Underground Storage Program839,700

13 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
15 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
16 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

18 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

19 For Chicago Fire Department Training Program2,267,700

20 For payment to local governmental agencies

21 which participate in the State Training

22 Programs950,000

23 Total \$3,217,700

1 Section 30. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
3 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
4 for the development of new fire districts.

5 Section 35. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
7 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
8 available for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS
9 administration.

10 Section 40. The sum of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
12 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for transfer to
13 the Fire Truck Revolving Loan Fund and the Ambulance
14 Revolving Loan Fund.

15 Section 45. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
17 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants for
18 the Small Equipment Grant Program.

 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect
 July 1, 2012.”.
