Makes appropriations of \$20,559,415 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for its ordinary and contingent expenses. Appropriates \$885,473 to the Office of State Appellate Defender for other expenses of the Office. Effective July 1, 2012.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
8 the Office of the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services .....	\$15,962,989
10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	1,221,169
11	For Contractual Services .....	2,162,100
12	For Travel .....	85,500
13	For Commodities .....	45,900
14	For Printing .....	46,400
15	For Equipment .....	44,400
16	For EDP .....	770,000
17	For Telecommunications .....	151,200
18	For Law Student Program .....	<u>69,757</u>

21 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much of  
22 those amounts, as may be necessary, respectively, for the

1 objects and purposes named, are appropriated to the Office  
 2 of the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to  
 3 federally assisted programs to work on systemic sentencing  
 4 issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed:

5 Payable from State Appellate Defender

6	Federal Trust Fund .....	\$210,000
7	Matching Funds payable from General	
8	Revenue Fund .....	<u>\$65,000</u>
9	Total	\$275,000

10 Section 15. The sum of \$242,100, or so much thereof as may  
 11 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General  
 12 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender  
 13 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement  
 14 Program.

15 Section 20. The sum of \$67,000, or so much thereof as  
 16 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the  
 17 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate  
 18 Defender to provide statewide training to Public Defenders  
 19 under the Public Defender Training Program.

20 Section 25. The sum of \$301,373, or so much thereof as  
 21 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the  
 22 General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate

1 Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
3 2012.
