Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 14 Section 20. The sum of \$939,800, or so much thereof as
- 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers'
- 16 Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers'
- 17 assistance programs.
- 18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 19 2012.
